**Deadline:** Friday 24 August 2018.

**Length:** Entries must be no more than 2,500 words.

**Topic:** Entries can deal with any topic relating to languages and linguistics – the important thing is that it is interesting and accessible for readers.

**Format:** Entries should be clearly presented in a Word file, with images submitted as separate JPEGs (or similar).
