Guidelines

Deadline: Friday 30 August 2019.

Length: Entries must be no more than 2,500 words.

Topic: Entries can be about any topic that relates to languages and linguistics – the important thing is that an article is interesting and accessible for readers.

Format: Entries should be clearly presented in a Word file, with images submitted as separate JPEGs (or similar).

Submission: Entries should be emailed to editors@babelzine.com with the title 16–18 Competition or Undergraduate Competition. 16–18 Competition entrants must provide details of their institution and a teacher; Undergraduate Competition entrants must submit via their university email address and provide contact details of a teacher.
